## Monument Repairs Continue

The Monument Company has repaired and cleaned 23 more old headstones for \$6,455, or an average of \$281 each. Newly restored headstones in Section A are: John H. **Sanders** Sr. (1810-1881) & John H. **Sanders** Jr. (1843-1892), W. T. **Toler** (1849-1896) & Annie **Toler** (1854-1922) & Emery E. **Toler** (1895-1947) & Claude C. **Toler** (1890-1917), Harrie D. **Collins** (1865-1910), Homer L. **Branham** (1862-1897), J. H. **May** (1846-1904), Arista Beulah **Sterns** (1882-1918), **Bell** (no names or dates), F. W. **Grota** (1860-1916). In Section B: Herbert J. **Sauer** (1910-1950), Emilie A. **Sauer** (1901-1962), Fred H. **Sauer** (1896-1941), Elise **Sauer** (1872-1959), F. J. **Sauer** (1871-1925). In Section C: C. H., Mary, Amalie, and Josephine **Hoенcke** (no dates) &

## Treasurer's Report (August 1, 1998)

During the last three months, we have received 33 donations from individuals, including a royalty trust certificate from Mr. **Elmo Calmes**, and a bequest from the estate of Mr. **William J. Holm**. We appreciate these generous contributions which will be used in the care and improvement of the cemetery grounds. Additionally, we added \$11,100 to our Improvements fund from the balance received on our first lot sale.

The unaudited combined financial statement of CCWCC and WCHT follows.

The total value of CCWCC is now about \$515,500, including \$428,200 in the Endowment Fund and \$52,800 in the Improvements Fund. The total value of WCHT is about \$27,900, including \$13,600 in the Improvements Fund and \$7,500 for road repair.
